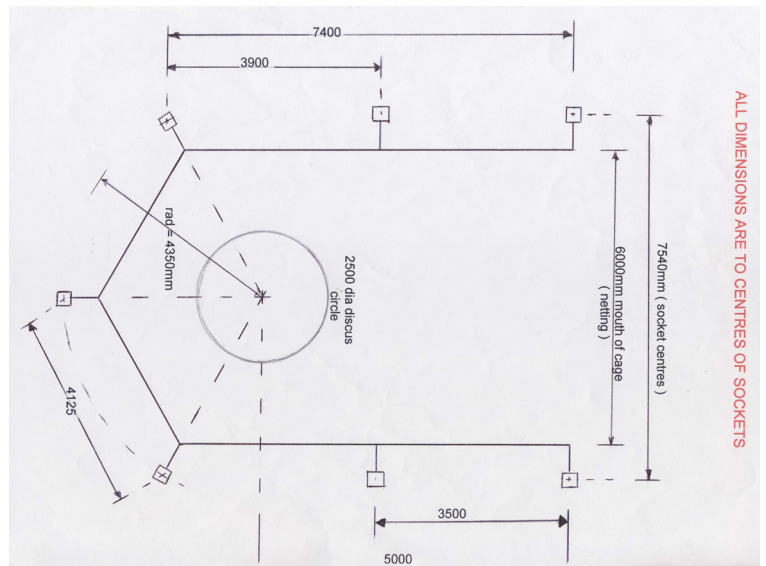


CANTABRIAN SCHOOLS DISCUS CAGE

- With seven - 3.3m high galvanized steel posts each 40mm x 40mm x 3.2mm, 533mm deep sockets and 3mm netting.

CANTABRIAN SCHOOLS DISCUS CAGE

Instructions for Erection of Schools Discus Cage

- Cut 7 ropes 6.5m long and thread through shackle at top of posts.
- Insert posts into sockets.
- Run a rope up 3.3m vertical face of netting (through each link) then along the whole top of net and again down the other 3.3m vertical face.
- Tie the 7 lifting ropes to the top of the net (also around the rope just threaded through) starting at the front corner of the net.
- Hoist the net up and tie the lifting ropes to the cleats on the posts.
- Pull tight on the rope from the two front vertical faces of the net. Try to take out as much droop out of the top of the net as possible. Now secure rope at ground level, via means of ground pegs or sandbags.
- Run another rope through the bottom of the net at ground level. This is to help stop net blowing in the wind and also stop discus going under net.
